

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 119

Ninth Street

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE GRADING, CURBING AND PAVING OF NINTH STREET, FROM FIFTH AVENUE TO SEVENTH AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR THE LETTING OF THE CONTRACT THEREFOR; AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE COSTS AND EXPENSES THEREOF FROM THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

Whereas the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City deems it advisable to grade, curb and pave Ninth Street, in said Borough, from Fifth Avenue to Seventh Avenue, and to collect two-thirds of the costs and expenses thereof from the properties abutting on the proposed improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That Ninth Street, in the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, from Fifth Avenue to Seventh Avenue, be graded, curbed and paved, and the same is hereby authorized and required to be graded, curbed and paved in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by the Borough Engineer.

Section 2. The secretary of council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for the grading, curbing and paving of that portion of Ninth Street, in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer.

Section 3. All bids for such grading, curbing and paving shall be received by the secretary of council at a meeting of council to be called for that purpose, and the proper officers of the Borough of Ford City shall thereupon award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, and shall enter into a contract with such successful bidder upon his giving bond in an amount equal to the tabulated amount of his bid with good and sufficient surety, conditioned for the faithful performance of the work in accordance with the terms of the contract, plans and specifications.

Section 4. The costs and expenses of said improvement to be estimated by the Borough Engineer, and shall be levied, assessed and collected from the owners of property abutting on the line of said improvement in the manner provided by The General Borough Act, approved May 14, 1915 P. L. 312, and the several amendments thereof and supplements thereto.

Section 5. All motions, resolutions, ordinances or parts thereof, conflicting with the foregoing, be and the same are hereby repealed.
