

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 16

An ordinance granting the Central District Printing Tel. Co. the right to construct, operate and maintain poles, fixtures, wires, cables and supports upon, over and along the streets, lanes and alleys of the borough of Ford City, Armst. Co. Pa. on the conditions hereinafter provided.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the borough of Ford City, County of Armstrong and state of Penna. and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section #1. The the privilege be and is hereby granted to the Central Dist. & Printing Telegraph Co., its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain such poles, fixtures, wires, cables and supports in and upon the several streets, lanes and alleys as may be necessary for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining lines of telegraph and telephones through said borough, also to the places of business, works, manufacturers, offices and houses of subscribers within the borough limits or adjacent thereto subject to the conditions hereinafter contained.

Section #2. The poles to be erected shall be of neat design and shall be erected under the supervision and control of the said council or its proper committee and to be erected at such points as said council or said committee may direct. The location of any of said poles shall be changed by said company when public convenience may require it upon (30) thirty days written notice, given by said council or said committee, provided such change shall not interfere with the practicability of maintaining such lines.

Section #3. That the said company shall leave all the streets, lanes and alleys, pavements, sewers and curbs in as good condition as they find them. If the said company shall neglect to do so, the borough authorities may, after thirty (30) days written notice to said company make such repairs and collect the cost thereof from said company.

Section #4. That whenever the said borough shall adopt a fire alarm or police telegraph system the said company shall permit the fire alarm or police telegraph wires to be run upon the poles of the said company without charge within the limits of said borough. Provided, however, that such privilege shall not be so exercised as to interfere with the proper use of said poles by said company. All such stringing or attaching of wires shall be done under the supervision of and to the satisfaction of said company. The said privilege shall not be transferable or sub-let except with the permission of said company.
