

# FORD CITY BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 169

## GATE HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, THE SLACKWATERING OF THE ALLEGHENY RIVER WHICH HAS NOW BEEN COMPLETED TO AND BEYOND THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY, IN ALL PROBABILITY WILL AFFECT THE SEWER SYSTEM OR MAINS OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY IN TIMES OF HEAVY RAINS, AS THE TOWN COUNCIL IS ADVISED BY ITS ENGINEER; and

Whereas, the rainy season of the fall season of the present year may begin at any time, in which event the Borough and its inhabitants may suffer severe loss and damage by reason of the probable clogging and overflow of said sewer mains; and

Whereas, it is important that work to avert such condition should be begun at the earliest possible date, looking to the construction and completion of a pump station with proper equipment to control said flood waters, but in the regular course of procedure, the law requires certain specified advertising for contracts and purchases where the amount to be expended is in excess of \$500.00, unless an emergency should exist, and be so declared by Council, in which event less period of time is required for such advertising;

Therefore, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, and said Council does now declare that an emergency now exists respecting the installation of a pumping system to control and relieve the sewer mains of said Borough, in cases of high water or flood water in said Borough.

Resolved further, that the said Borough direct and it does hereby direct the Secretary to give public notice to the effect that bids will be received, opened and read in an open meeting of Council at a time fixed by such notice, and said notice shall be published at least one week prior to the time fixed therein for opening bids, such notice to be published in one newspaper published in the County of Armstrong; all in accordance with the provisions of Article 12, Section 1201, Sub-section LIII, of the Act of May 4, 1927, P.L. 519, known as the Borough Code.

Whereas, the construction of the Pump Pit for the Eighth Street Sewer Pumps is now in course of completion and it being necessary to have the Sewer pumps at this station ready for operation at the earliest possible date to protect the sewer system of the Borough from being flooded in times of high water which may come at any time, and

Whereas, it is important for the protection of the pumping machinery that a building be erected over above mentioned pump pit as rapidly as possible, but in the regular course of procedure, the Law requires certain specified advertising for contracts and purchases where the amount to be expended is in excess of \$500.00 unless an emergency should exist and be so declared by Council in which a less period of time is required for such advertising; now

Therefore, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City and said Council does declare that an emergency exists respecting the construction of a pump building over above mentioned pump pit in order that the pumping system may be ready to control and relieve the sewer mains of the said Borough in case of high or flood water.

Resolved further, that the said Council of the Borough of Ford City herein and it does hereby direct the Secretary of Council to give notice to the effect that bids will be received, opened and read, in open meeting of Council at a time fixed by such notice and said notice to be published at least one week prior to the time fixed therein for opening bids, such notice to be published in one newspaper in the County of Armstrong; all in accordance with the provisions of Article 12, Section 1201, Subsection IIII, in the act of May 4th, 1927, P. L. 519, known as the Borough Code.
