

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 17

In place of Article 31.

Relating to Telegraph, Telephone, Elect. Light Co's., Street railway Co's. or Railroad Co's. poles and wires.

56 Section A. That every Telegraph Co., Telephone Co., Elect. Light Co., Street Railway Co. or Railroad Co's. poles and wires shall be inspected by the police department of said borough at least once in every year that the same may be kept in proper and safe condition.

56 Section B. That each pole maintained or erected in said borough shall be liable to an annual license tax of 50 cents and each mile of each strand of wire shall be liable to an annual license of 25 cents.

56 Section C. That said tax shall be paid to the treas. of said borough on or before the first day of March of each year, who shall issue his receipt then for showing the number of poles and miles of wire for which license tax is paid.

56 Section D. If any person or persons, company or corporation shall refuse or neglect to comply with the provisions of this ordinance he or they shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$100.00 to be collected by a suit in the name of the borough before the Chief Burgess or any Justice of the Peace for the use of said borough.
