

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 18

Granting to the Ford Natural Gas Company, its lessees, successors, and assigns, the right to enter upon the various streets and highways of the Borough of Ford City, and to lay and maintain its lines and pipes therein.

Section #1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that the Ford Natural Gas Company, its lessees, successors and assigns shall have the right to enter upon the various streets and highways in the Borough of Ford City and to lay and maintain its lines and pipes therein and operate the the same for the purpose of supplying natural gas for heat and light or either, provided that in so far as possible this right shall be exercised in the alleys of said Borough and not in the paved streets, all work to be done under supervision of street committee of Council.

Section #2. That the ordinance of the Ford Natural Gas Company be passed provided said Company complies with all the ordinances heretofore passed in regard to natural gas companies.

Ordained and enacted this 17th day of July, A.D. 1901, at a regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City held at the Council rooms of said Borough.

In consideration of this franchise, the Ford Natural Gas Company agrees to furnish fire and light for Hose House of Hose Company No. 1 so long as they supply natural gas to the public at Ford City.
