

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 24

An ordinance relating to the Throwing of Rubbish on the streets and alleys.

Be it ordained and enacted ny the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section #1. That any person Throwing or causing to be thrown on any of the Streets or Alleys of said Borough, any paper, tin cans or other rubbish, shall be deemed guilty of an offense, and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay a fine not, exceeding Five (\$5.00) Dollars and costs, or undergo an imprisonment not exceeding five days in the Borough lock-up or County Jail.

Section #2. Any and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance at an adjourned regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of Ford City Boro. held this 17th day of April A. D. 1903.
