

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 25

An Ordinance prohibiting the erection of Wooden or Frame Buildings within certain districts.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section #1. That hereafter no person or persons, corporation, partnership or otherwise howso-ever shall erect or cause to be erected any dwelling house, shop, warehouse, store, carriage house, stable or other tenement of any material other than brick or stone within the following limits:

beginning at the intersection of Ninth Street and Third Avenue, thence Eastwardly along Ninth Street to the intersection of Ninth Street and Fourth Avenue, thence Southwardly along Fourth Avenue to the ten foot alley North of lot No. 623, thence along said Alley Eastwardly to where said Alley intersects with the Alley between Fourth and Fifth Avenues, thence Southwardly along said Alley between Fourth and Fifth Avenues to where it intersects with the Alley North of lot No. 1040, thence along said Alley Eastwardly to Fifth Avenue, thence diagonally across Fifth Avenue to a point on Fifth Avenue on the line between lots Nos. 1041 and 1043, thence along said line between said lots eastwardly to the center of the Alley running North and South between Fifth and Sixth Avenues, thence along said Alley Northwardly crossing Ninth, Tenth and Eleventh Streets to the line between lots No. 1137 and 1139, thence along said line Westwardly to Fifth Avenue, thence diagonally across Fifth Avenue to the Alley South of lots Nos. 1142 and 755, thence along said Alley Westwardly crossing Fourth Avenue and along the continuation of said Alley to Third Avenue, thence Southwardly along Third Avenue to its intersection with Ninth Street the place of beginning.

Section #2. That any person or persons, corporation, partnership or otherwise howsoever violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be compelled to remove the structure or pay the costs of removal by the Council, with the addition of Twenty per centum, and also pay a penalty of Fifty dollars for every day the same shall remain standing within the limits prescribed in this ordinance, which penalty shall be for the use of the Borough and shall be collected as debts of like amount are now collected by law.
