

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 259

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1950 TO BE LEVIED UPON AND COLLECTED FROM ALL ASSESSABLE PROPERTY IN THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY, ARMSTRONG COUNTY, PENNA.

The Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Penna., ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That the millage or assessment for tax purposes in said Borough of Ford City for the year 1950 be and the same is hereby fixed and determined as follows:

For Public Library support, one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mill upon each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation,

For Bond redemption and interest, four and one-half ($4\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation,

For Sewer Fund, three and one-half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation.
