

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 26

Relating to the Erection of a Waterworks System for the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and the incurring of a Borough debt for such purpose.

Whereas, on the fourth day of August A.D. 1899, the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, did, by its proper Municipal Officers enter into a contract with the Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company, a Corporation for the proper supply of water to the said Borough from its reservoir and pipes for the period of five years, from the first day of January 1899. Which period of five years will have become terminated on the first day of January 1904, thus leaving the Borough without any reservoir or supply of water, and

Whereas, The Borough of Ford City has heretofore purchased from the said Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company in said borough, consisting of all mains branches, pipes, fire or water plugs, and all and every part of said system appurtenant thereto in said Borough, excepting those two certain mains leading from the reservoir to the works of the said Pittsburgh Plate Glass Co., and is now in full use and possession thereof:

Now therefore, Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, County of Armstrong and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same.

Section #1. That the Borough of Ford City shall provide a supply of water for the use of the public within the said Borough by the erection and operation of a water works, including the mains, reservoirs, buildings, pumps, and all and every kind of machinery and contrivances necessary or expedient for the successful operation of such plant, at an expense not to exceed Thirty Five Thousand, \$35,000.00, Dollars, provided the right to incur said indebtedness for said purpose shall be authorized by the duly qualified Electors of said Borough, which authority shall be ascertained in the manner now provided by law for the incurring of indebtedness by Municipal Corporation within this Commonwealth.

Section #2. That the Borough of Ford City shall incur indebtedness to the extent of Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Dollars, for the purpose of providing a supply of water for the use of the public within the said Borough by the erection and operation of a water works including the mains, reservoirs, buildings, pumps, and all and every kind of machinery and contrivances necessary or expedient for the successful operation of such plant, and the assent of the Electors of said Borough to such increase of indebtedness shall be duly obtained at the general election to be held in said Borough at the usual place for holding Elections, General and Municipal in said

Borough, on Tuesday the 3rd of November 1903, from 7 O'clock A.M. to 7, O'clock P.M. of said day, and that notice of the time and place of holding said election shall be given by advertisement in the Ford City News, a newspaper published in said district, during at least thirty days preceding said election.

Section #3. That the notice aforesaid shall contain a statement of the amount of the last assessed valuation of the amount of the existing debt, of the amount and percentage of the proposed increase, and of the purposes for which the indebtedness is to be incurred.

Done, Ordained and enacted at an adjourned regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County and State of Pennsylvania, held at Council Chambers in said Borough, on Monday the 10th day of August A.D. 1903.
