

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 29

An ordinance requiring owners of property within the limits of Ford City Borough, whose properties front on the Avenues and Streets of the Borough, to pave the sidewalk in front of such properties, and providing a remedy for their failure to do so.

Be it enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, County of Armstrong, State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

68 Section #1. It shall be the duty of the owner or owners of any lot or ground fronting on any Avenue within the limits of the Borough of Ford City to cause the sidewalks in front of such ground to be paved with flag-stone or cement and on any side street within the limits of said Borough to cause sidewalks in front of such ground to be paved with flag-stone, cement, hard burned brick or other material as directed by the Town Council, not less than five feet in width, and in conformity with the grades and lines established by the Borough and to keep them in complete and constant repair.

68 Section #2. If any person or persons shall neglect or refuse to pave, his, her, or their respective sidewalks or footways as hereinbefore provided, within sixty days after having been notified by the Town Council or Street Commissioner to pave the same, then it shall become the duty of the Council or Street Commissioner to cause the same to be done speedily at the expense of the Borough; Whereupon the Borough, by its proper officers, shall proceed as provided by law, to recover the amount so expended, with twenty (20) per centum added thereto as a penalty for such neglect or refusal, which sum or sums shall be paid into the Borough Treasury for the use of the Borough.

Section #3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, ^{be} and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance at a regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City held this fourth day of June 1906.
