

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF THE BELLWOOD GARDENS STORM SEWERS, SANITARY SEWERS AND GRADING AGAINST THE PROPERTY ABUTTING THEREON BY THE FOOT-FRONT RULE, A RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL DATED JULY 10, 1952

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1. The expenses of the installation of the sanitary sewers, storm sewers and grading, sluice gates, engineers' expenses, pumps and pump house building are hereby assessed against the properties fronting on the eastern side of Third Avenue, both side of Fourth Avenue, both sides of Fifth Avenue and the western side of Sixth Avenue, all of the avenues north of the Brown's addition in Ford City Borough on the foot front rule after deducting 1/3 of the cost of storm sewers, sluice gates, engineering expense, pumps and pump house building pursuant to the resolution of Council of July 10, 1952 as amended by resolution of Council dated August 17, 1953 stating that the grading is to be considered as part of the storm sewer work.

SECTION 2. The Borough Engineer is hereby authorized to make said assessment by certificate under the seal of the borough attested by the President of Council and the Borough Secretary. The Borough Secretary shall cause thirty (30) days notice of said assessment to be given to each party assessed, either by service on the owner or his agent or left on the assessed premises.
