

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 30

Resolution granting a General Permit to the American Natural Gas Co., to put in curb boxes on service lines for period of six months.

Whereas in case of fire it frequently becomes necessary to promptly shut off the supply of gas to the burning building.

And Whereas, in many places in the Borough of Ford City, the stop cock at the curb is buried so that the same cannot be reached, Therefore, be it resolved: That all persons owning buildings be and they are hereby notified to provide sufficient boxes around the stop cocks of their natural gas pipes so that the same can be promptly and easily shut off as necessity requires, within six months from the date hereof; and inasmuch as it is uncertain as to whether a permit be required for this purpose, and the American Natural Gas Co., which is the only Natural Gas Co., supplying gas in said Borough, has offered to place in front of all such buildings supplied by it the necessary curb boxes, a general permit be, and the same is hereby directed to be given to said Gas Co. by the Burgess for the purpose of making the necessary openings within six months from the date hereof, upon the said Company paying to the Burgess of the Borough the sum of Fifty Dollars for the said General Permit.

This resolution passed at the regular meeting held at Council Chambers on the third day of September A.D.1906.
