

# FORD CITY BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 32

An Ordinance authorizing the sale of a lot of land to F. C. Beecher, H. McD. McCue and J. K. Hosterman, and directing the proper officers of Ford City Borough to make, execute and deliver deed for the same.

Whereas, the Borough of Ford City in 1905 became the owner of a certain lot of land in said Borough by reason of an execution against V. Leebold, and which lot was bought for sufficient to pay said debt, but less than its value, and Whereas, F. C. Beecher, H. McD. McCue and J. K. Hosterman have proposed to purchase said lot from the Borough for the sum of Seven hundred fifty (\$750.00), That being the present value of other like lots in that locality, Now Therefore, Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section #1. That the Borough of Ford City hereby authorizes the sale of lot No. 569, lying between seventh and eighth streets in the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, fronting on fourth avenue twenty-five (25) feet and no (0) inches and running back one hundred forty (140) feet and no (0) inches to a sixteen (16) feet wide alley, to F. C. Beecher, H. McD. McCue and J. K. Hosterman, for the price of Seven Hundred Fifty (750.00) dollars.

Section #2. That the president of the Town Council and the Secretary thereof are hereby directed to make, execute and deliver to said purchasers the proper conveyance thereof.

Section #3. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance at a regular adjourned meeting of Burgess and Town Council of Ford City Borough held this 10th day of June A. D. 1907.
