

## FORD CITY BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF  
THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID BOROUGH OF FORD CITY,  
PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City,  
and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

SECTION 1. The Compensation of the several employees of the Borough of Ford  
City, Pennsylvania, herein enumerated, is fixed and determined as follows:
