

FORD CITY BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 369

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 328 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PENSION RIGHTS FOR EMPLOYEES OF FORD CITY BOROUGH UPON RETIREMENT, ENACTED THE 14th DAY OF FEBRUARY 1955, BY PROVIDING FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED AN ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 328, enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Ford City the 14th day of February 1955, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. RETIREMENT AGE AND SERVICE. The provisions of this pension ordinance shall apply only to those employees who have attained the age of sixty-five and shall have been upon retirement in the service of the borough for a period of fifteen years immediately preceeding his date of retirement. Provided, however, that any employee who shall have attained the age of sixty years and shall be totally disabled to perform his service to the borough, which disability shall be evidenced by a certificate in writing by a licensed and practicing physician, and who has met all of the other requirements of this ordinance including the fifteen year prior service may apply to Council for immediate disability retirement, which disability retirement may be granted by Council at their discretion."

Section 2. The effective date for the provisions of this Ordinance shall be the first day of October 1957.

Section 3. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they affect the provisions of this Ordinance.
