

FORD CITY BOROUGH

ORDINANCE NO. 37

An Ordinance fixing the amount of the bond to be given by the Solicitor of the Boro. of Ford City, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Boro. of Ford City, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

Section #1. That the person elected Solicitor of the Burgess and Town Council of the Boro, of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania shall give a lawful bond to the said Burgess and Town Council of the Boro. of Ford City with one or more sufficient sureties to be approved by the Town Council in the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of his official duties as the same are or may be defined by law or Ordinance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed in so far that the same conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
