

AN ORDINANCE WIDENING FIFTH AVENUE BETWEEN FOURTH STREET AND FIFTH STREET, PURSUANT TO PETITION OF MAJORITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND FIXING THE GRADE THEREOF.

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BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD  
AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME.

Section 1. Fifth Avenue between Fourth Street and Fifth Street is  
widened, pursuant to the plan of the Borough Engineer to include the land  
described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the western line of the present Fifth Avenue  
at the southeast corner of Lot No. 872 in the general borough plan;  
thence by land of Adam Gerboc and wife and Polish Falcons of America  
North 60 degrees 00 minutes East 108.0 feet to a point; thence by  
lands of Polish Falcons in a northeasterly direction on a curve to  
the left, radius 231.0 feet, 100.0 feet to a point on the present  
western line of Fifth Avenue; thence by said present western line  
of Fifth Avenue South 36 degrees 30 minutes West 130.0 feet to  
a point; thence by same South 81 degrees 30 minutes West 110.0 feet  
to a point, the place of beginning.

Section 2. The grade of the widened portion of Fifth Avenue described  
above shall be in conformity with the present grade of Fifth Avenue at the same  
place.

Section 3. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the petition of a  
majority in number and interests of the owners of the property abutting on the  
western line of Fifth Avenue between Fourth Street and Fifth Street.
