

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 42

Providing for an increase of the indebtedness of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, in the sum of sixteen thousand (16,000.00) dollars, to purchase the plant of the Ford City Electric Light, Heat and Power Company, and providing for the submission of the question of increasing said indebtedness to the qualified electors of Ford City Borough to be decided by ballot.

Whereas, by agreement made and entered into on the 21st day of February, A.D. 1899, the Borough of Ford City contracted with the Ford City Electric Light, Heat and Power Co. to supply light to it for a period of ten years from March 30th, 1900. and

Whereas, under the authority of the laws of Pennsylvania the Council of Ford City Borough has agreed to and with the holders of all the stock in said Ford City Electric Light, Heat and Power Co. to purchase their stock and the entire plant of said Ford City Electric Light, Heat and Power Company for the sum of sixteen thousand (\$16,000.00) dollars.

Now therefore, Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

Section #1. That the indebtedness of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania be increased in the sum of sixteen thousand (\$16,000.00) dollars over and above the present indebtedness, for the purpose of purchasing the real estate, equipment, rights and franchise of the Ford City Electric Light, Heat and Power Co., Provided, however, that the right to so increase said indebtedness shall be authorized by the qualified electors of said Borough in the manner provided by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section #2. That the question of increasing said indebtedness as provided by section one hereof, be first submitted to the qualified electors of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, at an election to be held at the usual place for holding general and municipal elections in said Borough on Friday, the 18th day of December, A.D. 1908, from 7 O'clock A.M. to 7 P.M. of said day.

Section #3. That the notice or notices and statements required by law in such elections be published in the Kittanning Tribune and in the Kittanning Free Press, two weekly papers published in the Borough of Kittanning, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, there being no paper published in Ford City, and that twenty hand-bills be posted in the most public places in said Borough of Ford City, for a period of thirty days next preceeding the time for

Section #4. That said notice or notices and statement or statements shall contain a statement of the amount of the last assessed valuation of taxable property in the Borough of Ford City, the amount of the existing indebtedness of the said Borough, the amount of the percentage of the proposed increase, and the purpose for which such indebtedness is to be increased.

Done, Ordained and enacted into a law at a regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, held at City Hall, this 2nd day of November, A.D.1908.
