

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 59

DEDICATION ORDINANCE

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same.


Section #1. That the following described lots or parts of lots in the Borough of Ford City, County of Armstrong and State of Pennsylvania, all being designated herein according to the general plan of lots of said borough as recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for said county in Deed Book, Vol. 90, pages 16 to 20 inclusive, to-wit:- All of lot No. 304; all of lot No. 303; all of lot No. 278; that certain tract of land beginning at the intersection of the westerly line of Third Avenue with the southerly line of O'Conner Street; thence easterly along said southerly line of O'Conner Street, forty four (44.00) feet to the dividing line between lots No. 279 and No. 281; thence southerly along said dividing line at right angles with said southerly line of O'Conner Street, one hundred six (106.00) feet to the northerly line of a thirteen (13) foot alley, which alley is parallel with O'Conner Street; thence westerly along said northerly alley line, forty (40.00) feet to a point; which point is four (4.00) feet easterly from the intersection of said northerly alley line with the easterly line of Third Avenue; thence northerly parallel with the easterly line of Third Avenue, and four (4.00) feet easterly therefrom, seventy one (71.00) feet to a point; thence westerly at right angles with the last above described line, four (4.00) feet to a point on the said easterly line of Third Avenue; thence northerly along said easterly line of Third Avenue, thirty-five (35.00) feet to the southerly line of O'Conner Street at the place of beginning, being all of lot No. 279 and part of lot No. 277; that certain tract of land beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of Tenth Street with the dividing line between lots No. 254 and No. 256; thence westerly along said northerly line of Tenth Street; forty (40.00) feet to a point, which point is four (4.00) feet easterly from the intersection of said northerly line of Tenth Street with the easterly line of Third Avenue; thence northerly, parallel with and four (4.00) feet easterly from said easterly line of Third Avenue, one hundred six (106.00) feet to the southerly line of a Thirteen (13) foot alley; which alley is parallel with Tenth Street; thence easterly along said southerly alley line forty (40.00) feet to the above mentioned dividing line between lots No. 254 and No. 256; thence southerly along said dividing line, one hundred six (106) feet to the northerly line of Tenth Street at the place of beginning; that certain tract of land be-

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northerly line of Ford Street; thence northerly along said easterly line of Third Avenue, fifty (50.00) feet to a point; thence easterly at right angles with said easterly line of Third Avenue, twenty two (22.00) feet to a point on the line dividing lots No.228 and No.230; thence southerly along said dividing line, fifty (50.00) feet to the northerly line of Ford Street; thence westerly along said northerly line of Ford Street, twenty two (22.00) feet to the place of Beginning, being the southerly half of lot No. 228; that certain tract of land beginning at the intersection of the southerly line of Ford Street with the easterly line of Third Avenue; thence southerly along said easterly line of Third Avenue, forty (40.00) feet; thence easterly at right angles to said easterly line of Third Avenue, twenty-two (22.00) feet to a point on the line dividing lots No.227 and No.229; thence northerly along said dividing line, forty (40.00) feet to the southerly line of Ford Street; thence westerly along said southerly line of Ford Street, twenty two (22.00) feet to the place of beginning, being the northerly end of lot No.227; be and the same are hereby opened and dedicated to public use, thereby widening Third Avenue in said Borough at the points on said Avenue vacated by ordinance of even date herewith, so that the said Avenue may be of practically the same width as heretofore.

Section #2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Done, ordained and enacted into a law at a regular meeting of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, County of Armstrong and State of Pennsylvania, held this 5th day of January, AD 1914.


