

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 6

To Prohibit the Maintenance of Uncovered Aerial Ways.

5 Section #1. That after the passage of this ordinance, no person shall maintain or cause to be maintained within the said borough, any uncovered Aerial ways, and all such uncovered Aerial ways are hereby declared to be a nuisance.

5 Section #2. The Town Council may require the abatement, or cessation of all such uncovered Aerial ways, by the owners or owner thereof within ten days after the service of a written or printed notice to so abate or cause a cessation of the same. All said property owners in said borough are required to cover all aerial ways with iron gratings, said gratings to be on a level with the sidewalks. Any owner or occupant refusing or neglecting to comply with the requirements of such notice shall forfeit and pay a fine to the Treasurer of the said borough of not less than one dollar nor more than ten dollars for every period of twenty-four hours such uncovered aerial way, declared to be a nuisance, shall be permitted to remain after the expiration of the said period of ten days aforesaid and in default of payment of said fine, shall undergo an imprisonment of not more than five days in the lock-up or thirty days in jail.

Ordained and enacted into a law in Council this 4th day of August, A. D. 1899.
