


FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 69


An Ordinance repealing Sections Two, Three and Four of an ordinance enacted July 5th, 1911.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.


