

FORD CITY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 8

An Ordinance establishing the width of third avenue, in the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, and vacating such portions of Third Avenue as lie between the western line of Third Avenue as herein established and the western line of Third avenue as heretofore established.

Section #1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Ford City, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, that the width of Third avenue is hereby established as follows, to wit:

The eastern line of Third Avenue shall remain as heretofore established.

The western line of Third Avenue, from the southern end of Ford City to a point thirty-eight and eight-tenths (38.8) feet south of the south line of Third Street shall remain as heretofore established. At a point two hundred sixty-nine and seventy-eight hundredth (269.78) feet north of the north line of Third Street, the width of Third Avenue shall be forty-four and sixty-eight hundredths (44.68) feet.

At a point forty-seven and forty hundredths (47.40) feet north of the north line of Fourth Street, the width of Third avenue shall be forty-one and seventy-seven hundredths feet (41.77). At a point one hundred and eighty-one and five tenths (181.5) feet north of the north line of Fourth Street the width of Third avenue shall be twenty-five feet (25) shall extend northward to a point one hundred forty-three and five tenths (143.5) feet southward from the center line of Fifth street. At the center line of Fifth street the width of Third avenue shall be forty-three (43) feet which width of forty-three feet shall be preserved throughout running northward to the south line of the first alley above Ninth street, Northward from this last named point Third avenue shall remain in width the same as heretofore established.

Section #2. All those portions of Third avenue lying between the western line of Third avenue as herein established and the western line of Third avenue as heretofore established are hereby vacated.

Section #3. All ordinance or parts of ordinance conflicting with this ordinance are hereby repealed in so far as the same affects this ordinance.
