

Rules and Regulations for the Ford City Playgrounds

1. No one is allowed in the playground after the gates are locked.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times.
3. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by a parent or a guardian who is 14 or older.
4. No glass bottles or containers are allowed in the playgrounds.
5. No alcoholic beverages.
6. No throwing of rocks, sticks, sand, or woodchips.
7. No bicycle riding is allowed in the playground.
8. No swearing, teasing, or abusive language.
9. No pushing, shoving, or hitting.
10. No one is allowed to climb the trees or fences and no one is allowed to be on the roof of any buildings.
11. Anyone caught stealing, vandalizing, or destroying playground equipment will have their name reported to the Ford City Police Department.
12. Smoking is not permitted in the playground area. Adults who wish to smoke must do so outside the fenced area.
13. Free lunches are for the children only! No adult may order a free lunch for himself or herself. All free lunches are to be eaten in the playground area.

The playground supervisor or aid has the authority, given to them by the Ford City Borough Council, to suspend the use of the playground to anyone who disobeys any of the rules.
