

**MINUTES
FORD CITY BOROUGH COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING

MARCH 23, 2005**

- CALL TO ORDER Council Vice-President Homer Pendleton called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- ROLL CALL Terry Tokarek, Homer Pendleton, Tim Malec, and John Rudosky were present. Dan Cousins and Steve Kozuch were absent.
- ATTENDANCE Mayor Lux and Solicitor Frank Allan Wolfe were also present.
- AUDIO-TAPED Vice-President Pendleton advised the audience that the meeting was being audio taped.
- BILLS TO APPROVE
Rudosky made a motion to approve the payment of bills in the amount of \$1,339.34. Seconded by Malec. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous [ATTACHED]
- TRUCK REPAIR ESTIMATE
Rudosky made a motion to authorize Councilman Malec to obtain estimates for repair of the 1975 Dodge and the orange dump truck and he may drive the truck as needed in order to obtain the estimates. Seconded by Tokarek. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous
- ZONE RIVERBANK Rudosky made a motion to authorize Solicitor Wolfe to prepare an ordinance zoning the riverbank of the former PPG Property as open space. Seconded by Tokarek. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous
- TRAFFIC SIGNS Rudosky made a motion to order six (6) traffic signs in the amount of \$598.50 to be used on 5th Avenue at Ford Street and near Ford City High School. Seconded by Malec. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous
- OFFICE WORK Rudosky made a motion to hire Katherine Czekanski at a rate of \$6.00 retroactive to January 1, 2005 allowing only 119 work days from that date for temporary office work. Miss Czekanski will be scheduled by the Borough Secretary. Seconded by Tokarek. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous
- ADJOURNMENT Rudosky made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:08 p.m. Seconded by Tokarek. Motion Carried. 4-0 Unanimous
