

ORDINANCE NO. 603

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 499 OF THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY, KNOWN AS THE EARNED INCOME TAX ORDINANCE; PROVIDING THAT THE TAX COLLECTOR SHALL REFUND TAXPAYER'S EARNED INCOME TAX PAID ON BUSINESS EXPENSES NOT PAID BY THE TAXPAYER'S EMPLOYER.

The Council of the Borough of Ford City hereby ordains as follows, under the authority of the Act of December 31, 1965, P. L. 1275 (53 P. S. 6901, et seq.), known as the Local Tax Enabling Act:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 499 as supplemented and amended by Ordinance 514 of the Borough of Ford City is hereby further supplemented and amended by adding Section 4A which shall read as follows:

Section 4A. The tax collector shall refund, on petition of, and proof by the taxpayer, earned income tax paid on the taxpayer's ordinary and necessary business expenses, to the extent that such expenses are not paid by the taxpayer's employer.
