

ORDINANCE NO. 622

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE
INTERSECTION OF HILL STREET AND SHORT STREET

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Ford City Borough Council, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to authority of 75 Pa.C.S.A. Section 6124, Erection of traffic-control devices at intersections, Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81, Section 1, effective July 1, 1977, as amended, it is hereby directed that three (3) stop signs be erected at Hill Street and Short Street, Ford City Borough, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania, to direct that all vehicular traffic stop at this intersection before proceeding and that furthermore, the design and placement of said stop signs shall conform to all applicable law.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
