

ORDINANCE NO. 667

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE STOPPING OF VEHICLES AT THE INTERSECTION OF 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND SIXTH AVENUE WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF FORD CITY; PROVIDING FOR PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Ford City Borough Council, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to authority of 75 Pa.C.S.A. Section 6109(a)(6), as amended, the driver of a vehicle shall be required to stop at the following locations before proceeding:

1. The driver of a vehicle traveling north on Sixth Avenue shall stop at the southerly side of the Sixth Avenue-9<sup>th</sup> Street intersection before entering the intersection; and

2. The driver of a vehicle traveling south on Sixth Avenue shall stop at the northerly side of the Sixth Avenue-9<sup>th</sup> Street intersection before entering the intersection.

Section 2: The penalties for violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be specified by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

Section 3: Proper signs which conform to the requirements of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation shall be erected at the locations

specified herein.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
