

**MINUTES
FORD CITY BOROUGH COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
LOCATION – FORD CITY PUBLIC LIBRARY
APRIL 12, 2010**

CALL TO ORDER Council President Lux called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. and advised the audience that the meeting was being audio and video taped by Family Life TV. Lux questions if anyone is audio or video taping this meeting? There was no response. He then asks everyone to please place their phones on vibrate. If you must answer, step out of the meeting.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Lux lead the everyone in reciting the pledge of allegiance.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Lux read prepared announcements. (Attachment)

ROLL CALL

Ron Dillard, Lou Vergari, John Lux, Ray Klukan, Paul Harmon, Rob Mohny, and Mayor Mantini were present.

ATTENDANCE

Frank Wolfe, David Nichols, David Croyle, Mitch Fryer, Jerry Miklos, Bill Oleksak, Tom Shaffer, Chris Zionkowski, Zoltar Kupas, Jim Smerick, Chuck Pascal, Brenda Vargo, Roxanne Smerick, and John Rudosky were also present.

MINUTES

Klukan made a motion to approve the minutes for 3-8-2010. Seconded by Harmon. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Dillard explains the addendum to the 11-9-2009 minutes. The addendum will be entered into the minutes. Dillard requested the verbatim addendum.

Mayor Mantini asked Jerry if he wanted verbatim.

Jerry Miklos felt pertinent information was omitted and didn't request it be done verbatim.

Dillard made a motion to enter the addendum to the 11-9-2009 minutes. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried. 3-0
Vergari, Mohny, and Harmon abstained. [Not council members during 2009.]

POLICE REPORT

Mayor Mantini read the March 2010 Police Report. (Attachment)

Mantini reported 15 vehicle's tires got slashed before Easter. Call 911 if you have any information.

Mohny made a motion to accept the Police Report for March 2010. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Klukan made a motion to hire David Fisher as a part-time police officer for the normal (12) twelve month probationary period, passing a physical examination, psychological examination, and background check to be performed at the direction of the Sgt. in Charge and the Mayor and to be paid the current wage of the part-time police officer.
Seconded by Mohny. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Harmon read the Water Reports and informed the public that the Water Reports are available in the Borough Office.

Klukan made a motion to accept the Water Reports. Seconded by Vergari. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Harmon read the Treasurer's Report and bills to approve.

Mohny made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report for February 2010 and pay the bills in the amount of \$54,107.25 as approved by the Finance Committee. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Vergari has questions regarding Treasurer Reports for February and the general fund paid bills. Lux and Dillard explain the Treasurer Report and the paid bills.

ENGINEER REPORT

Nichols reads the Engineer Report and discusses two items. (Attachment)

#1. Heating System Evaluation - proceeding with preparing bid documents and looking into Growing Greener Funding for the project..

#2. Joint Water Authority - Looking for monies to modify an old plant. Suggestions have been made to look into the feasibility of combining with Manor Township.

Vergari asks the engineer if there is money available if a more efficient boiler is purchased.

Nichols states possibly Growing Greener Money.

Dillard made a motion to approve the Engineer's Report. Seconded by Harmon. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS

Regular Council Meeting

BOILER 5-10-2010 Nichols states the advertisement could be ready for the next council meeting [5-10-10].

BOROUGH MANAGER

Lux asked this item to be placed on the agenda and explains that he would like to advertise to see what kind of applicants would be interested. Lux states that he began re-writing job description using Ordinance 666. He would like feedback or suggestions from council of any qualifications that he may have missed. Would like job description complete before advertisement of position. Lux would like to find out who is out there and who is interested in interviewing. Questions wages that would be acceptable.

Dillard asks how borough plans on paying for this.

Lux answers the Borough Foreman will be retiring in December.

Dillard questions cost of his retirement.

Lux states that there will be no cost from the general fund.

Dillard asks "We aren't paying from general fund?"

Lux tells him not that he knows of.

Bittner states that the Borough Foreman's pension is covered by the pension plan. Insurance is full coverage until he turns 65.

Dillard states council needs to look ahead at what costs will be needed towards the foreman's retirement. Dillard feels it would be better to have a Borough Manager in place before the Borough's foreman retires. Dillard feels knowledge needs to be shared and that the borough needs to try to have a seamless entry into the new year.

Lux does not want to hire someone right away, need to know what kind of wages we are looking at.

Dillard requests, when council interviews for borough manager position, that not just personnel committee conduct the interview.

Lux states the involvement of all council is needed.

Vergari feels all of council should get together to discuss what council expects of borough manager and what authority they have.

Harmon feels the borough manager position will save the borough money in the long run.

Dillard feels the borough needs to get away from a working supervisor. Supervisor should not pick garbage, should supervise. Council is part time

bosses, borough needs turned around.

Lux states that there will not be a working supervisor, will make sure people are doing their jobs.

Lux states that the right person will answer to council and let council know what is going on. Council should not have to spend more than 10 hours per week at borough.

Bish reads from borough codes book. Section 1141 states that the borough manager position must be created and regulated by ordinance.

Lux states that borough does have an ordinance and that only thing not in ordinance is the qualifications.

Bish continues about job description being in ordinance and questions Lux's procedure.

Lux tries to explain to Bish what he meant by needing a job description for the position.

Bish states that powers and duties of a borough manager must be regulated by ordinance. Feels everything should be done with ordinance before advertising and determining salary. Bish reiterates that she feels the ordinance must be complete.

Lux states that the ordinance was done years ago and has a job description.

Bish questions why a job description is being discussed if there is one in place in the ordinance.

Lux comments that the insurance company needs an updated job description for each position in the borough.

Bish feels that it would be better for council to have a job description in the ordinance entailing what the manager is to do during a 40 hour work week.

Lux states that ordinance #666 is the ordinance in question.

Bish asks if this has already been written and passed.

Lux answers yes.

minutes 4-12-2010 Regular Council Meeting approved 5-10-2010 Mantini states that the ordinance was written and passed about 5 years ago.

Bish feels it should be revised.

Harmon states that the ordinance was passed in May of 2006.

Lux states that the ordinance is all set up.

Bish questions Lux to make sure everything is there in the ordinance and that someone can be hired.

Mantini states that this is all new to borough. Makes a suggestion to contact colleges that have this program, and to contact surrounding boroughs who have a manager in place.

Mantini states a Borough Manager may bring in grants four times the wage.

Tom Shaffer states he is not applying for this position. Shaffer states this is simple. A description is in ordinance but may limit applicants by including qualification in the ordinance.

Dillard states he does not feel it is that simple. This is a new council and I am not sure I agree with ordinance #666. Dillard explains he does not agree with way it is written needs some discussion to make sure we get the person we need.

Mohney made a motion to advertise. Seconded by Harmon. Motion Carried 4-2. Dillard and Vergari vote no until modifications are made.

HERITAGE DAYS Klukan made a motion to approve the request of Ford City Area Heritage Days as per their letter dated 3-25-2010 with the exception of parking in the Heritage & Industrial Park.
Seconded by Dillard. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Dillard concerned with vendor on private property.

Solicitor Wolfe stated that it happened about a year ago and doesn't remember the details. It somehow was resolved.

Dillard stated that the vendor on private property added confusion to the process. Council talked about resolving so there would be no issue in the future.

Dillard to Bittner - Please review to make sure we came up with a resolution.

CATCH BASIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Lux to Dillard - Need to get the information gathered up so borough can be reimbursed for the work that was done last summer.

Dillard states he has information and knows it has to be taken care of.

Mayor Mantini states Jan Lysakowski completed grant for \$32,000. Asks to make sure this gets completed.

COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

HANDICAP COMMITTEE

Vergari made a motion to appoint Diana Mantini to the Handicap Committee. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

PLANNING COMMISSION

Harmon made a motion to appoint James Solak to the Planning Commission. Seconded by Mohney. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

BOARD OF HEALTH

Lux would like to hold off on appointments to Board of Health until requirements are verified.

SEWAGE AUTHORITY

Vergari nominates Terry Tokarek who is presently the authority president, in middle of a project. Seconded by Dillard. Roll Call Vote

Dillard - YES	Harmon - NO	Vergari - YES
Mohney - NO	Lux - NO	Klukan - YES

Mayor Mantini breaks the tie with a - NO

Vergari comments that this is impossible to understand.

Mantini states that the sewage authority has not had an audit for years.

Vergari explains the reason there was no audit done. The outfit fell apart, they had all the authority records, went with police to get papers after four years. Every audit is now up to date and has nothing to do with Hoss Tokarek.

Brenda Vargo comments that all of council got copies of audit in January 2010. The sewage authority engaged new auditor, satisfied with position of authority, Hoss doing good job.

Mantini asks Lux if he was made aware of all issues with the sewage authority audits.

Lux answers no.

Mantini questions if there is an attorney on sewage authority.

Chuck Pascal states he was not attorney until 2008. Jim Panchik was the attorney before him. Comments that members of council also serve on authority. Audits were done as soon as auditors were replaced.

Vergari feels there is no one more qualified than Hoss. Council is not using common sense, board is being run by someone not on council.

The authority found another auditor, sewage authority has money,

somebody wants on authority to get the money.

Mantini states that the accounting firm found years ago that there was a discrepancies with Borough monies .

Miklos recollects that at the time they were a good accounting firm.

Mantini asks Pascal what happens when an audit is not completed.

Pascal states that we attempted to get it done. They had all the sewage records.

Mantini states that if audit is not completed for one years time then Borough steps in to complete the audit. Mantini questions Vergari why that wasn't done?

Vergari states they were a good firm.

Mantini questions why borough wasn't notified.

Vergari states that the firm asked the authority to give them some time.

Lux was told in January that there was an audit problem.

Mantini questions why he was not told prior to that.

Pascal states that borough would know they didn't receive an audit from authority.

Mantini made his decision with a vote.

Vergari reiterates that the firm was once reputable and figured they would get caught up. Nothing malicious was done by sewage authority.

Vargo wants explained why borough does their audits on a cash basis.

Harmon questions Vargo about all audits being up to date. Borough is being accused of shortfalls.

Vargo states where there is proof in paperwork.

Harmon states that he found where payments were made to the authority. If you would wait until 2009 audit you will see the payments.

Vargo wants to know why she should wait for 2009 audit to be done to get payments from 2006, 2007, 2008.

Harmon feels that Vargo should wait for all audits to be complete before accusing the borough of owing money to the authority.

Lux questions why brought up at a meeting and put in newspaper.

Vargo states that auditor discussed this with secretaries. Members of council sit on board and council knew. Questions why council not getting information from council members who also sit on authority. States it is not her fault that people are not giving you information. States she is not getting information that is supposed to be provided from the borough.

Harmon states that amount keeps changing.

Vargo comments if you read the transactions you will understand what is going on.

Harmon states that we'll sit down and talk about. Harmon has the details now and will provide to Vargo.

Vargo - sure.

Klukan questions Vargo why wait three years to switch auditors.

Vargo states couldn't get documents, needed police.

Mantini states sewage authority is important.

Vergari comments that the problem with audits has been solved.

Dillard nominates Bob Ware.

Wolfe states must specify length of terms.

Vergari states that we don't know the length of the terms. Not sure what the length should be, don't think Lisa or Jim Smerick actually know when appointments are up. No letters were put in to stay on boards, automatically Vergari and Tokarek's terms were up, questions who made that decision.

Roxanne Smerick reads passage from January minutes. Asks why we would want to change when we have a major project going on.

Mohney asks Vargo who sat on council and sewage simultaneously.

Vargo states Hoss and Lou.

Mohney states reference to information not getting back to council, those are the people.

Mohney questions if they were elected to better Ford City, mis-communication here, people still there to complete project, asked specific questions if my block was included and was told no.

Lux states he was told he got a notice, his side of 5th avenue didn't get a notice.

Roxanne Smerick is asking council to work with sewage authority to move project forward and resolve issues, should have no more fighting.

Lux states not trying to stop project.

Harmon comments that people on both council and authority spend different amounts of time working.

R. Smerick states that there is a mis-communication problem. Jim Smerick has worked for sewage authority for 37 years, he is the right person to ask questions.

Jim Smerick comments that John Lux was right about block. There was a mis-communication between office staff and the map they were given. Hand delivered letters this morning.

Mantini comments that went to a sewage meeting, well run operation, clean, efficient, highly regulated.

Smerick comments that not every person on authority has information of day to day operation of plant.

Harmon questions if any section on 7th Avenue is involved in project.

Jim Smerick answers 6 homes, 7th Avenue ext.

Lux asks if any second for Bob Ware.

Motion dies for lack of a second

Harmon nominates Tom Shaffer to serve a 4 year term. Seconded by Mohney. Roll Call Vote

Dillard - NO	Harmon - YES	Vergari - NO

Motion Carried 4-2.

Bish questions terms of people on sewage authority.

Solicitor Wolfe states that each term is a 5 year term.

Mohney made a motion to appoint Chris Zionkowski to the sewage authority for a 3 year term. Seconded by Harmon. Roll Call Vote

Klukan questions if CDL is needed in the advertisement. Dillard states it is not needed.

Dillard made a motion to advertise for Temporary Summer Labor. Seconded by Mohny. Motion Carried 6-0

Terry Tokarek asks why Career Link program is not utilized.

Dillard states that borough didn't have sufficient full time supervisors, didn't come with crew leader.

Dillard states that the temporary worker can work up to 38 hours.

Mohny made a motion to destroy tax collector records from 2000 and 2001 as listed. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Mantini questions if it is appropriate to destroy these records.

Lux answers yes.

Vergari made a motion to approve the request of Ford City Hose Co. #1 to hold a "Mock Accident" on Wednesday, May 12, 2010 on 2nd Avenue and 3rd Avenue from 11th Street to 12th Street from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and inform the Street Dept. the Police Dept., Myers Bus Company, and Mid-County Transit. Seconded by Mohny. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

DCED REPORT 2009

Harmon made a motion to advertise the summary of financial information in the Leader-Times prepared by the Borough auditors Maher Duessel for the period ending 12-31-2009. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

EXCO RESOURCES - BULK WATER SALES

Council President Lux (needs 1,000,000 gallons per day)

Mohny made a motion to forward Exco a letter explaining to them we are unable to provide them any water based on their 1,000,000 gallon per day request. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Solicitor Wolfe explains inspector cost were reduced from \$28,000 down

to \$22,000.

Dillard made a motion to authorize the Council President and the Borough Secretary to sign the settlement agreement with ACA Engineering in the amount of \$22,000.00. Seconded by Klukan.
Motion Carried 5-0. Vergari abstains.

Hoss asked how much was bill before it went to, why wasn't original bill paid?

\$23,716.18 - original

Mohney states borough is money ahead.

GAZEBO

Klukan made a motion to grant permission to the Darlene Varholla to reserve the Gazebo on Saturday, May 15, 2010 from 3:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and inform the Street Dept. and Police Dept. Seconded by Vergari.
Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Klukan made a motion to grant permission to the Ford City Ministerium to use the Gazebo and Ford City Park from Monday, August 9 to Friday, August 13 as per their request for their annual Vacation Bible School and inform the Street Dept. and Police Dept. Seconded by Harmon.
Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Vergari made a motion to grant permission to the ARIN Intermediate Unit to reserve the Gazebo and the Ford City Park on Saturday, April 16, 2010 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and inform the Street Dept. and Police Dept. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Klukan made a motion to grant permission to Kathy Dubiel to reserve the 7th Avenue Playground on Saturday, June 19, 2010 as per her request. Seconded by Mohney. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Vergari questions if playgrounds are open to public while parties are going on.

Harmon made a motion to grant permission to the Senior class of Ford City High School use of the Gazebo and the park on Friday, May 14, 2010 as per their request for their Grand March and inform the Street Dept. and Police Dept., Myers Bus Company and Mid County Transit. RUPERT CONDITIONAL USE HEARING

Mohney made a motion to enter the Decision of Council for the David Rupert Conditional Use Hearing held on Tuesday, March 16, 2010 into the records of the Borough. Seconded by Dillard.
Motion Carried 5-0. Klukan abstained. (Attachment)

OLD BICYCLES Klukan made a motion to ratify the advertisement that the Police Department will be disposing of unclaimed bicycles. Seconded by Dillard. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

PLANNING COMMISSION - RESIGNATION

Mohney made a motion to accept the resignation of Brenda Vargo from the Planning Commission pending her submission of a signed letter. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

HANDICAP APPLICATION

Dillard made a motion to approve the recommendation of the Handicap Committee dated 4-1-2010 to install four (4) Handicap Signs. Seconded by Klukan. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

FEASIBILITY STUDY

Dillard questions if borough is looking at doing away with the water plant. Nichols states the study would look at serving both Manor Twp. and Ford City Borough.

Mohney made a motion to authorize David Nichols - Borough Engineer to work with the Engineer representing MTJMA and the Borough Solicitor to conduct a feasibility study of the possibility of combining the water systems. Seconded by Dillard. Motion Carried 6-0. Unanimous.

Dillard states Ford City system is different, we rely on gravitational feed. If Ford City was pressurized every pipe in town would blow.

Nichols states not going to do that. Lines would not pressurize. Utilize wells to supply treatment plant. Lots of questions to be answered.

Mantini states that good point was brought up by councilman Dillard. Would like green information.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Kim Bish questions council who is on the finance committee.

Lux responds John, Paul, Rob.

Bish questions storage of KPM equipment and boxes. Questions when, who, what, or if any lease. States she should've completed a Right to Know Form. Feels any income generated from the storage should go to pay the mortgage. It is borough owned property until the 23rd and would like to know who entered into agreement about storage, lease agreement.

Klukan states that they asked permission to use as storage.

Bish questions for over a year. Borough still owns and it is wide open. Entered into lease with Caracal for \$10,000 per month. Was told they did not honor full term of lease. Bish states John is president of council and is on finance committee and has to know this.

Lux states that lease was not honored.

Solicitor Wolfe comments that borough could pursue if wants to, statute of limitations has not expired.

Bish states borough is owed \$90,000.

Solicitor Wolfe states Bank has claim on lease money. Borough had no obligation to pay. Caracal #2 did make some payments.

Bish states she could have been parking her car in the parking lot for free.

Bob Ware states that property in the building can be sold.

Bish states anything KPM has in building can be sold.

Bish brings up Right to Know - asked for Wolfe compensation amused by response.

Solicitor Wolfe states that Bish is not asking the right question. Must ask for what you want to see.

Bish interrupts Wolfe and reads what records include.

Solicitor Wolfe reiterates she must ask for a record. Must specify document, not all records are available for public review.

Bish states it does not state she must ask for a record.

Solicitor Wolfe must ask for a specific record.

Bish reads what paperwork says.

Solicitor Wolfe states she must ask for a specific record, what she is asking for is not a record, ask for redacted copies, copies of checks, must ask for a document, probably be specific, redact priv. information.

Bish complains about other questions not answered and states she shouldn't have to be a lawyer to ask a question. Shouldn't have to tell borough how to answer questions.

Solicitor Wolfe states she needs to rephrase.

Bish tries to explain as a common person. Bish states that Wolfe can review to see if she is allowed access.

Solicitor Wolfe states she can ask for checks and add them up herself.

Bish asked about roof being put out to bid. Needed to ask for document.

Bish asked if Tom Shaffer repaid his stipend. Bish can't see why she

needs to be an attorney to properly ask questions.

Mantini to Bish - Tom paid it back

Bish asks when.

Mantini - God bless Councilman Shaffer for turning it back

Jerry Miklos - February 28, sent council a letter, waiting for an answer, was told on 3-8-10 he would have an answer at the 4-12-10.

Miklos to Dillard questions when questions in letter will be addressed.

Dillard states to let Council President answer.

Lux states that he will have to go back and review to get up to speed.

Miklos states he is just looking for answers.

Lux comments that he will get back to Miklos.

Miklos comments that there are a lot of questions that need answered. Asks all councilman individually if they have any answers for him.

Miklos states he is just looking for answers to his questions. Something has got to happen, this has been a long, drawn out affair.

Miklos suggests council to give letter to solicitor.

Miklos states there is a big problem here. BOH not meeting, asks Klukan if he agrees.

Klukan agrees

Miklos asks if the board is still being paid.

Council does not know.

Dillard tells Miklos to address the Finance Committee

Lux thinks they didn't ask for any money this year.

Miklos states someone has to know where the money is going. You have had this letter for two months, if you are spending tax payer dollars on a board that is not meeting...

Miklos questions postponement of appointing to Board of Health vacancy. Questions if people have applied. Lux states yes. How did person know to apply when it was not advertised. Came into office and inquired. Miklos asks if going to advertise. Isn't that the protocol. Do you feel it is right to spend taxpayer dollars on a group that is not functioning?

Lux states that borough can advertise

Harmon - \$1500 line item, he'll check if they are getting paid.

Miklos questions when last audit of BOH took place.

Lux states never.

Mantini states that the accounting has commented that the borough is in the best financial position that it has been in years.

Lux states he will sit and discuss with Solicitor Wolfe.

Bob Ware commented that he had big interview for sewage authority and questions if Mantini is part of council. Wants to know why mayor was included in the interview process. Always step in and open your mouth.

Mohney states he was there that evening.

Ware questions what was so wrong with interview that couldn't even get a second. Was on authority in 1976. You have put a person on there that has no experience. Why no second?

Ware- Don't even know why? Someone needs to know what was wrong with interview.

Mohney states maybe others interviewed better.

Ware tells Mantini not to say anything.

Mohney states that the mayor did ask your permission to ask you a question in the interview and you replied yes.

Mantini states could have protested. Invited by council. Asked councilman if I asked question.

Ware - Am I the wrong color?

Mantini- Let's not go that way. Best not accuse me of that.

Ware - I accuse you of it.

Solicitor Wolfe tells the mayor he is better not to answer Ware why he was not chosen for the sewage authority

Dillard mayor shouldn't sit in on any interviews, not appropriate.

Solicitor Wolfe states there is no hard and fast rule.

Ware tells Mantini he shouldn't have been there. Has no right to interview person.
